Pool play result tiebreakers are determined by run differential used by the SPC for seeding purposes. In the event of a pool tie I will inform you of the pool winner based on head to head result. A three way pool tie will be determined by run differential to eliminate one team and then go to head to head result.

All games will be one hour fifty minute time limits with no inning starting after the time limit. In a tie game we will determine a winner based on runners to third base in pool play. If still tied, we will go to runners to second base. If still tied we will go to total runners. If still tied, we will flip a coin to determine a winner. We will have a winner for every game.

Home team for each game will be determined by a coin flip except for when you play TJCS or TWCA. In those games, TJCS and TWCA will be the home team.
